We'll also hear from our keynote speaker, Dr. Daniel Jaffee, as he speaks

Daniel Jaffe is the Jane and Roland Blumberg Professor of Astronomy at the University of Texas. He studies how stars and their accompanying planetary systems form. He analyzes infrared light that allows his instruments to penetrate the dust clouds that surround these young systems.

As part of his work, Jaffe develops new instruments and devices. Currently, one of his instruments is on the Gemini South 8m telescope in Chile. A suite of his devices on the recently

launched James Webb Space Telescope helps scientists to discover galaxies in the early universe and study the atmospheres of planets around other stars. Dan currently serves as UT's Vice President for Research.

These one-time award scholarships of \$2,500 made a real difference to these students in choosing their college, in determining their ability to live on campus, and in making a dream become reality.
